Dialogue of the BC's ENEMLOS team with the acting head of the Higher State Prosecutor's Office in Podgorica

The project manager of the ENEMLOS project, **Dr. Nina Radulović**, with the secretary Ivana Aničić, were hosted by the acting head of the Higher State Prosecutor's Office, **Ms. Lepa Medenica**, on October 8 this year. The meeting was held on the subject matter of the mechanism of implementation of the ENEMLOS project in cases of official defenses according to national regulations.

Ms. Medenica pointed out a number of difficulties that could arise when including the ENEMLOS project in cases prosecuted at the initiative of their prosecutors. Dr. Radulović presented the implementation model, within the competences of the Bar Chamber, which integrates practical solutions for successful overcoming of these difficulties. The importance of acquainting students - participants of the clinic with the type of criminal offenses within the competences of the Higher Prosecutor's Office was also emphasized.

The participants agreed that it is very important for the national legal system to make progress in terms of the early inclusion of young legal professionals in the legal profession. A mutual belief has been expressed that the meeting in question is the beginning of a beautiful future cooperation that shall enable the achievement of the project's goals.

Dr. Radulović announced and informed about the need and intention to hold similar meetings with authorized representatives of other judicial institutions responsible for the implementation of the project. Primarily, these are institutions of higher judicial instance, which are signatories to the international agreement on the implementation of the project. Moreover, dialogue shall be open with equally important institutions of lower legal instance directly responsible for the legal cases that are in the focus of the project. The key for the success of the project relies in the exchange of experiences, ideas and good will.

- PROPOSED DIRECTION FOR PROJECT ACTIVITIES:
- Due to the unpredictable COVID-19 situation, project activities that are feasible regardless of the pandemic situation should be implemented in due time. This applies especially to certain tasks, implementation of which is not affected by the specific circumstances created by the pandemic, such as project strategic documents based on which activities should be performed, such as Dissemination Strategy, Quality Assurance Plan and Sustainability Strategy;
- - If the COVID-19 situation continues, the possibility of organizing relevant activities virtually should be considered, in order not to cause major project delays;
- - The project has started well its dissemination, which is considered very positive. This practise should be followed by all partners in the period to come. The relevant information about project goals, expected impact and importance should be distributed through all available dissemination tools;
- - The project official website should be regularly updated. It should contain all the necessary information, not only about its description, but about the implementation process as well. All the project relevant materials, activities conducted and results reached should be published. Information on the implementation progress in Kosovo partners should be provided on the website as well, in order to equally disseminate project results that have been achieved in all partners in consortium;
- - The involvement of non-academic partners is essential for achieving the objectives of the project. In case there is a risk of the lack of interest and motivation for legal professionals to be engaged in the operation of legal clinics, an internal action plan between local partners about organization of tasks should be developed in order to accomplish the project duties. Nevertheless, taking into account the role of non-academic partners in some of key project deliverables, their proper engagement in relevant project activities is expected.

Erasmus+ proposed directions for post-project activities of ERASMUS

- The Ministry of Justice is involved as an associated partner, but its role in the project implementation remains vague. The Ministry could play an important role especially in the sustainability of the key project deliverables. Therefore, it should be more involved, as it could help in ensuring the financial sustainability of legal clinics after the EU support ends.

Sustainability of the project should be considered from the very beginning. The legal clinics established and the engagement of legal professionals from judiciary should be well thought out in the Sustainability Plan. Financial sustainability of the legal clinics after the project ends, is not sufficiently elaborated, and should be further defined.
