MONITORING PROJECT OF ERASMUS+ MONTENEGRO DATE 24 JUNE, 2021 PLACE: FACULTY OF LAW, UoM The cooperation between academic and non-academic partners should be further strengthened, in accordance with the dynamics of the project implementation, as the role of non-academic partners remains to be seen at a later stage of the project implementation, i.e. upon the establishment of legal clinics, since more room for their active involvement is planned to be made at the latter stage of the project implementation.

- The dissemination activities should be continued and further intensified (especially in local media); the growing importance of these activities is to be evidenced upon the establishment of legal clinics, as this information should be disseminated in order to reach a great number of potential stakeholders.

- It is also highly recommended to re-establish cooperation with the ENEMLOS project partners through participation in mobility projects (especially with University of Zagreb, bearing in mind the fact that, in this case, the language barriers do not exist), in order to further deepen and strengthen already established cooperation.

- More interaction with members of WG in charge of working on Law on HE should be done, since some parts of the Law would be related to the practical part of studying (25% of practical education per academic year, according to the Law on Higher Education), which is legal clinics in this case, bearing in mind that legal clinics are aimed at providing students with practical education,

- The lack of support of the Ministry of Justice, involved in the project implementation as an associated partner, is still present; this institution should be more active in the project implementation.

- Inter-project coaching with CB HE "Strengthening capacities for the implementation of dual education in Montenegro higher education", DUALMON, 2020 project is recommended to be achieved, since there is a common element of both projects, i.e. practical education

Erasmus+ proposed directions for post-project activities of ERASMUS

• The Ministry of Justice is involved as an associated partner, but its role in the project implementation remains vague. The Ministry could play an important role especially in the sustainability of the key project deliverables. Therefore, it should be more involved, as it could help in ensuring the financial sustainability of legal clinics after the EU support ends.

Sustainability of the project should be considered from the very beginning. The legal clinics established and the engagement of legal professionals from judiciary should be well thought out in the Sustainability Plan. Financial sustainability of the legal clinics after the project ends, is not sufficiently elaborated, and should be further defined.
